Upper-level history courses, 24 credit hours

24 semester hours of advanced work (3000-4000 level), with four courses in a single geographic area, at least one course in each of the remaining geographic areas, and two courses in a single theme.

Each student will choose a geographic focus area for his or her advanced course work by taking at least four courses in one of three groups:

United States

Europe

Africa, Asia, Latin America, and the Middle East

Students must take at least one course from each of the other two geographic areas outside of their focus.

Each student will also select one of the following themes by taking two courses within that theme:

Culture and Everyday Life

Empires and Borderlands

Food and the Body

Gender and Sexuality

Mass Violence and Atrocities

Politics, Policy, and Economics

Premodern Europe and the Mediterranean

Race and Ethnicity

Texas, the South, and the West

War, Military, and Society

Students must finish a history course with a grade of C or better for it to count toward the history major.
